## NOTICE OF REGULAR ELECTION

**NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN** that the City of Soldotna Regular Municipal Election will be held on ***Tuesday, October 3, 2017***, for the purpose of electing the following officials:

**Mayor:** One to be elected by the qualified voters of the City of Soldotna for a three-year term.

**City Council Members:** To be elected by the qualified voters of the City of Soldotna.

- City Council Member, Seat B, one to be elected for a three-year term.
- City Council Member, Seat F, one to be elected for a three-year term.

**VOTER QUALIFICATIONS:** A qualified voter is a person who is a citizen of the United States, is at least 18 years of age, has been a resident of the State of Alaska and the City of Soldotna for at least 30 days immediately preceding the election; and is registered to vote in state elections at a residence address within the city at least 30 days before the city election.

**POLLING PLACE:** Soldotna City Hall, 177 North Birch Street, Soldotna, Alaska

**POLLING HOURS:** The polls will be open from 7:00 a.m. to 8:00 p.m. on Election Day

**ABSENTEE VOTING:** Any qualified voter may vote an absentee ballot for the precinct in which he/she resides and is registered. Absentee voting in person begins September 18, 2017 at the Kenai Peninsula Borough, 144 N. Binkley Street, Soldotna, Alaska. Absentee Ballot Applications are available at City Hall or on the City Website [www.soldotna.org/government/city-clerk/elections](http://www.soldotna.org/government/city-clerk/elections). Applications for Absentee by Mail Ballots must be received no later than September 26, 2017 and applications for Electronic Transmission Ballots must be received no later than October 2, 2017. If you are unable to go to your polling place because of an illness or disability you may apply for a special needs ballot. For additional information, contact the City Clerk at 907-262-9107.
